The Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art offers Laurel Award Internships which provide hands-on museum experience in education, collections management, and curatorial. Graduate students interested in museum careers or in learning more about the functions of an art museum are invited to apply. Laurel Award Internships, available for one to three terms, are an ArH 609 graduate course, and carry 4-5 graduate credits per term. Interns must commit to at least fifteen hours per week to the Museum for which they receive full tuition reimbursement for each term selected.

Applications for Laurel Award Internships must:

- be a full-time enrolled graduate student for the academic year 2015-16
- have a GPA of 3.0 or higher

To apply, please submit the following information no later than May 8, 2015:

- cover letter outlining how the internship experience will enhance scholarly or professional goals
- resume/curriculum vita
- writing samples
- three letters of recommendation
