FACILITY RENTAL RATES

Private events may take place during or outside of museum hours of operation. The selected space would be reserved one hour prior to and one hour after the event. Cleaning fee required. **Renters must be museum members at the \$100/year or above level.**

2. **The Cheryl Ramberg Lecture Hall
North Courtyard ***

up to 118 max. (1,800 sq. ft.)
up to 100 max. (1,500 sq. ft.)

Includes non-exclusive use of the Hope Hughes Pressman Lobby & Price Lucien Campbell Memorial Courtyard, Coat Room/Interactive Discovery Gallery, Galleries, and Restrooms during Museum hours. Exclusive use of these spaces may be available when Museum is closed to the public. **Galleries available for rent for museum members at the \$250.00/year or above level.**

3. **Hope Hughes Pressman Lobby and
Prince Lucien Campbell Memorial Courtyard**

up to 80 max.

Exclusive use of the Lobby and Memorial Courtyard are only available when the museum is closed to the public.

Museum approved caterers are UO Catering or Marché. Contact information is available from JSMA events coordinator.

RENTAL RATES (includes one hour set-up and one hour tear down/take-down services)

Base rental rates apply to each rental space individually. Multiple spaces may be rented simultaneously. Special rental rates will apply. Additional charges may apply if set-up and load out require extra time in the space.

Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art may change these rates without notice. Rates stated in a signed and properly executed Letter of Agreement with deposit and Certificate of Insurance/Endorsement would be honored. Payment must be paid in full prior to the event.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

Security	\$50/hour	Museum Security must prepare the building for guests and modify security systems. Museum Security must be posted at all access points into the Museum including the Lobby to monitor the front door during the event, South and/or North Courtyard, and other entrances during the set-up and clean-up of the premises. Once guests and clean-up crew leave the premises, Museum Security will proceed to secure the building for the evening. Museum will determine the number of security personnel required based on estimated attendance and number of spaces required.
Event Staff	\$25/hour	Museum Facilities must prepare the spaces for an event and clean the premises after the event. The Special Events Manager or her designee must be available to assist during the set-up, actual event, and tear down.
Custodial	\$25/hour	Minimum of 1 hour, to be determined based on the nature of the event and level of event catering.
Cleaning Fee	\$100	Damage may result in additional charges.

Overtime charges are billed at 1½ times the regular rates.

Staffing

A Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art supervisor and staff will be on site throughout the rental to oversee the event.

General Information and Policies

A 50% deposit of estimated total rent is required at time of event date confirmation.

Rice, bird seed or confetti may not be thrown inside or outside of the building. Rose petals are bio-degradable and may be used outside.

Flowers must come from a commercial greenhouse.

Decorations and posters may not be taped or tacked to the walls or furniture. Please discuss plans with Facility Rental Staff to determine what will be possible.

Art work may not be moved or removed.

With the exception of guide and assist dogs, pets are not permitted in the Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art.

Smoking is not permitted in the Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art at any time or in the outdoor spaces directly outside the museum.

We recommend that renters allow 15-30 minutes to gather all personal items and belongings. This clean up time should be considered and factored in as a part of the time rented in the facility. The Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art is not responsible for personal items left in the museum.

Renters are required to obtain liability insurance prior to having an event in Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art.
